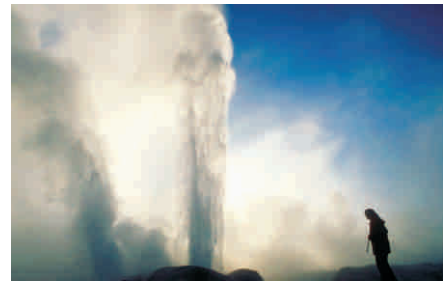

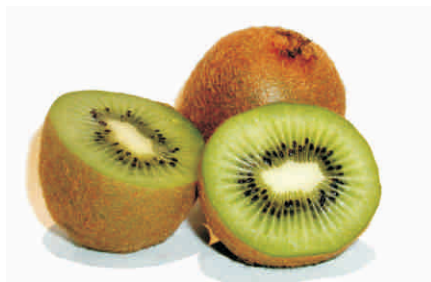

Day Wise Itinerary



Day 1

Arrival in Melbourne

Welcome to the city that knows how to live. Choose from high-end cuisine to low brow rock gigs, plays, and festivals, all taking place across a city full of parks, gardens and historic architecture. After immigration and customs, meet your MakeMyTrip representative outside in the waiting area. Board the coach for your transfer to the hotel. Check in to the hotel. You have the rest of the day free to explore your surroundings and visit nearby shopping areas. Later, you may visit Eureka Skydeck 88 (optional) and experience the awe inspiring view of Melbourne from the Southern Hemisphere's highest viewing platform. You can also enjoy 'The Edge' which will make you experience Melbourne in a unique way; sitting in a glass cube which projects 3 metres out from the building and is suspended almost 300 metres above the ground. Overnight stay at the hotel in Melbourne.

Day 2

Melbourne - City Tour

Day 4

Auckland City Tour

Visit the famous Auckland landmark of Mount Eden, a dormant volcano whose summit offers excellent panoramic views of the city and harbours. From this fantastic vantage point you will see evidence of Auckland's volcanic history, the most significant being the youngest volcano of Rangitoto Island at the entrance to the Waitemata harbour. The sightseeing tour also takes in the Auckland Domain, the city's oldest park which is situated on a 62,000 year old volcano. In addition to these natural features the city sights tour also takes in the trendy shopping area of Parnell Village with its historical buildings that have been transformed into boutiques, antique, craft and specialty shops. Your tour will then take you along the scenic waterfront route of Tamaki Drive before returning to Downtown. Later, visit Kelly Tarlton's Underwater World, a world-class visitor attraction, offering a uniquely New Zealand Pacific and Southern oceans experience. The Antarctic Encounter is home to New Zealand's only sub-Antarctic penguins, offering a rare opportunity to see the magnificent birds up close in their icy domain. A unique snow cat ride brings you within arm's length of the 80-strong colony of King and Gentoo penguins to watch their playful antics on the snow and their elegant flight underwater. Enter Stingray Bay for an awe-inspiring look at the giant stingrays, before delving deep into the Underwater World to see the rich variety of species from New Zealand's coastal waters. Come face to face with sharks, turtles, giant rays and other incredible deep sea creatures on the moving walkway. Enjoy rest of the day at leisure. Overnight stay at the hotel in Auckland.

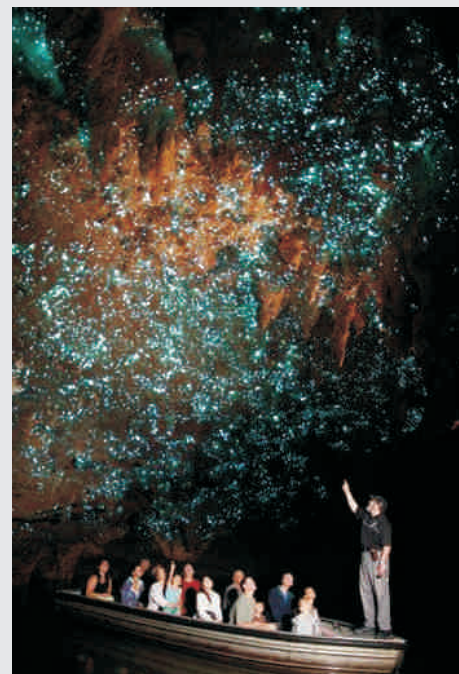


Day 5

Auckland - Rotorua

Rotorua

Hot springs, boiling sulphurous pools, silica terraces and bubbling mud pools are among the natural wonders. Following this, **visit Rainbow Springs** to see New Zealand's trout, birds and wildlife. Where else can you see kiwi foraging in their natural habitat, a huge array of wildlife, trout being hand fed in beautiful spring fed pools and stunning New Zealand landscape. Later, continue to **the Agrodome for a New Zealand farm show** featuring sheep dog demonstrations, cow milking and an introduction to the stars of our sheep industry. 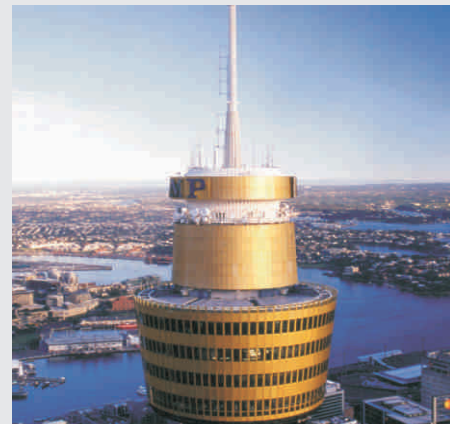
Sydney Aquarium
