Day 3: Netherlands

After the demonstration, take a photo stop at a windmill, one of the most distinctive sights of the Netherlands.

For tours between late March and mid-May: Proceed to Keukenhof, which is the world's largest Tulip garden. Open from late-March to mid-May, it attracts over a million visitors - in a mere eight weeks - who come to see the vibrant flowers (tulips, daffodils, and many more) in full bloom.

(Please Note: The Keukenhof Gardens are open from late- March to mid-May only. Groups on the tour commencing post mid-May shall visit Madurodam in The Hague instead.)

For tours after mid-May:

Later, visit Madurodam, which is a beautiful miniature model of a typical Dutch town, downsized in the ratio of 1:25. It also contains many famous miniature landmarks, which are absolute copies of the real ones. Enjoy a comfortable overnight stay at the hotel.

Day 4: Orientation Tour of Brussels - Paris- City Tour and Eiffel Tower (Optional: Le-Lido Show and An Evening in Paris along with a visit to Montparnasse Tower)

Later, proceed to Paris and begin your orientation tour which includes sights such as Arc De Triomphe, Champs Elysees, Grand Palais, Petit Palais, National Assembly, Alexander Bridge, Concorde Square, Magdalene Church, Opera Garnier, Louvre Palace, Cite Island, French Academy, Sorbonne University, Orsay Museum, Church of the Invalides, Military Academy, Trocadero Square and the



PalaisDe Chaillot. Visit the most famous landmark of Paris, the Eiffel Tower, and enjoy a panoramic view of the city from its 3rd and topmost level. Built in 1889 and designed by the young engineer Gustave Eiffel, the tower stands 324 metres (1,063 ft) tall.

After checking-in to the hotel, enjoy your time at leisure **OR** embark on an exceptional optional tour, An Evening in Paris which includes drives past the famous monuments and buildings of Paris at night to witness their dazzling illumination, along with this we visit the Montparnasse Tower, which is a 210 meter skyscraper and is one of the tallest skyscrapers in Paris, enjoy Parisian's most outstanding monuments and neighbourhoods from the 56th floor. Continue on the optional tour to experience one of the most famous night shows in the world called 'Lido De Paris'. Day 5: Paris - Disneyland

Day 7: Austria – Innsbruck - Capital of Tyrol and Swarovski Showroom and Museum

Thereafter, proceed to the world-famous Swarovski Crystal Showroom and Museum to take a look at the amazing collection of precision-cut lead crystal glass and other related products. Admire and shop to your heart's delight, amongst the largest exhibits of the Swarovski Crystal collection. We proceed towards Munich and enjoy a comfortable overnight stay at the hotel.

Day 8: Munich – Onto Prague

After breakfast today, we proceed to Munich, which is the largest city and the capital of the state of Bavaria and the third largest city in Germany, the world famous Oktoberfest is held here. We begin our city tour which includes sights such as Marianplatz, which is the central square in the city center of Munich, along with sights like Hofbrauhaus, which is a brewery, the Neues Rathaus, which is the town hall, Glockenspiel, the clock tower which at once in a day chimes and re-enacts two stories from the 16th century, along with this we also visit St. Peter's Church, which is the oldest church in the city of Munich. We proceed towards Prague and enjoy a comfortable overnight stay at the hotel.

Day 9: Czech Republic - Prague – Onto Vienna

After a scrumptious breakfast, we visit Prague, the capital and largest city of the Czech Republic. This city is a beautiful treasure trove of Gothic and Baroque architecture we begin the city tour with the Prague Castle – residence of Czech kings; St. Vitus cathedral – one of the biggest and the most beautiful in the world. After the Prague castle tour, we proceed along the Kings' road to the lesser town area. Here, one can admire the St. Nikolas Church – the best sample of Baroque in Prague. Proceed to the world famous Charles Bridge. Continue the city tour with the Old Town Square – with famous astronomical clocks. It is the historical center of the city and site of many significant events. From here, we proceed to the Jewish quarter, which is remarkable with seven synagogues remains from this old settlement that includes the Jewish Town Hall and the Old Jewish Cemetery – the oldest in Europe. Later, proceed to Wenceslas Square, which is the shopping center of Prague and also consists of the statue of St. Wenceslas with four patron saints of Bohemia and a neo-Renaissance building of the National Museum. We proceed towards Vienna and enjoy a comfortable overnight stay at the hotel.

Meals: Breakfast, lunch and dinner



Day 10: Vienna City Tour and visit to Schonbrunn Palace along with Bratislava

After breakfast today, we visit Vienna, the capital city of Austria and its cultural, economic and political centre. Few cities in the world glide so effortlessly between the present and the past like Vienna. Its splendid historical face is easily recognized grand imperial palaces and bombastic baroque interiors, museums flanking magnificent squares and, above all, the Hofburg – where the Habsburg rulers lived, loved and married into empires. The capital scores highly, thanks to the first-rate musical and cultural attractions at its concert halls, museums and theaters - from the Golden Hall of the Musikverein to the acclaimed Museum of Fine Arts and the State Opera House. Vienna is also a byword for epicurean enjoyment, with centuries of traditions shaping its coffee houses and Heuriger wine taverns. On arrival, we begin our city tour with the most significant sights of Vienna. Along the Ringstrasse, we see magnificent buildings, such as the MAK, the State Opera House, the Museum of Fine Arts and the Natural History Museum, the cultural district, the Museums Quartier, the former Habsburg winter residence, the Hofburg, the Parliament, the City Hall and the Burgtheater. Later, visit the Schonbrunn Palace which was the summer residence of the Austrian emperors for nearly 150 years. It was built between 1695 and 1749 with over 100 rooms and beautiful gardens. After this, we proceed to Bratislava – the capital of Slovakia. It is also the political, cultural and economic centre of Slovakia. Bratislava is neatly divided by the Danube River. On the north bank are the less attractive high-rise blocks erected under communist occupation (1968-89), these are comparatively tiny but beautifully restored historic quarter of the Old Town (Stare Mesto), now devoted almost entirely to tourism.

Bratislava Old Town, much of which is pedestrianized, is characterized by its charming Hapsburg Baroque architecture, including many former palaces. Hlavne Square sits at its heart, containing the Old City Hall, and parallel, running north to south, the old Michalska and Venturska streets lead past a number of historical sites. The town has a rich musical pedigree and includes the childhood performance venues of Mozart and Franz Liszt. ZelenáUlica runs off Michalska and is one of the narrowest streets in the city, home to Academia Istropolitana, the first university in the Hungarian Kingdom. Don't miss a stroll along the charming pedestrian promenade which begins at the National Theatre with its statuary, fountains and many cafés. At the other end of the Old Town is St Martin's Cathedral, which hosted the coronation of exiled Hungarian kings during the period when most of Hungary was under Ottoman rule. The city also boasts a number of copper-domed churches, palaces, and, just outside the walls, the dominant landmark of Bratislava Castle. Enjoy a comfortable overnight stay at the hotel.

Meals: Breakfast, lunch and dinner

Day 11: Onto Italy - Venice



After enjoying breakfast, we depart for Venice, which is known as the Queen of the Adriatic. Also fondly called La Serenissima, Venice is built on 180 islands that are connected by over 400 bridges, with hundreds of canals criss-crossing the town. For more than a thousand years, the city was one of the most enduring mercantile sea powers on Earth. Venice represents an urban landscape so rich in its lavishness that it can be overwhelming. It seems as if at each step you will encounter some aspect of the city worth admiring. Enjoy a comfortable overnight stay at the hotel.

Meals: Breakfast, lunch and dinner

Day 12: Venice Orientation tour, Train journey to Rome, City tour of Rome

After a scrumptious breakfast, we proceed to visit Venice, Sail in a special water taxi to the St. Marks Square, which is considered to be one of the world's most beautiful squares with its boutiques, traditional cafes, and historic buildings. On your city tour see incredible sites such as the Bridge of Sighs, the Ducale Palace, St. Mark's Basilica and the Clock tower which are part of this romantic city. After exploring the city of Venice, we proceed to Rome by train, the Venice-Rome route in one of the most popular routes in Italy, sit back and enjoy the magnificent experience as we travel across from Venice to Rome. On Arrival, embark on a guided city tour of Rome and witness sights such as the Colosseum, Arc of Constantine, Roman Forum and Caesar's Forum. Drive past the Venice Square to experience the stark contrast between the architecture of the traditional Palazzo Venezia and the modern Victor Emmanuel Monument. Later, visit the Trevi Fountain, which is considered to be the most beautiful fountain of Rome (legend has it that if you make a wish and throw a coin in, your wish will come true and you will return to Rome). Thereafter, drive past Palatino hill to witness the beautiful church of Santa Maria Maggiore. Enjoy a comfortable overnight stay at the hotel.

Due to coach and traffic regulations and the heritage status of the city of Rome, the city tour of Rome may be subject to change.

Meals: Breakfast, lunch and dinner

Day 13: Vatican City and Florence - the Jewel of Renaissance

After enjoying breakfast, visit the Vatican City, which is also the smallest country in the world. Begin a guided tour of the Vatican starting with the Vatican Museums, which is believed to house the world's greatest collection of art. The tour will culminate with a visit to the exquisite Sistine Chapel, which is best known for its outstanding frescoes on the ceiling and altar walls. Thereafter, visit the magnificent St. Peter's Basilica, the most famous church of the Christian world. St. Peter's Basilica has an astonishingly harmonious appearance and radiates tremendous grandeur through its architecture and magnificent interior decorations. Stroll



among the famous colonnades of St. Peter's Square to mark a perfect ending to your tour of the Vatican City.

Later, we proceed to Florence to embark on a walking tour, visiting sights such as, the Cathedral of Santa Maria del Fiore, Campanile and Baptistery. Enjoy some free time in Piazza Della Signoria to view Palazzo Vecchio, the Loggia Dei Lanzi and the Fountain of Neptune. Other sights on the tour include the various sculptures that make Florence a virtual open air museum, the courtyard of the Uffizi gallery and Ponte Vecchio, which is the oldest and the most famous bridge in Florence. Enjoy a comfortable overnight stay at the hotel.

Meals: Breakfast, lunch and dinner

Day 14: The Leaning tower of Pisa – Onto Switzerland

After breakfast, we visit the historic university city of Pisa - famous for its architectural beauty. Upon arrival, visit the Campo Dei Miracoli and enjoy stunning views of the Leaning Tower of Pisa, the Cathedral and the Baptistery of Pisa. The Leaning Tower of Pisa is one of the most remarkable architectural structures from medieval Europe. It has mystified and amazed crowds for hundreds of years, and despite having experienced many a calamity during its lifetime, it is still standing. Hereafter, continue your journey to Switzerland, which is a landlocked country in the cultural and geographical centre of Europe. Renowned for its snowbound Alps, lush green meadows and fresh water lakes, the prosperous country of Switzerland is blessed with a distinct character and dynamism. Enjoy a comfortable overnight stay at the hotel.

Meals: Breakfast, lunch and dinner

Day 15: Switzerland (Optional Tour of Jungfrauochand Interlaken with Indian Lunch)

After breakfast today, enjoy the day at leisure in the serene and soothing environs of Switzerland OR make use of the free time to embark on an optional tour to visit Jungfrauoch, often referred to as the Top of Europe. Also, visit the charming town of Interlaken. Jungfrauoch makes for a memorable encounter with snow and ice, and has all it takes to become the high point of any tour of Europe. Tourists are often amazed at the scenic splendour they witness from the Cog-Wheel train that climbs up to a height of 11,333 feet to reach Jungfrauoch, the highest railway station in the world. The Cog- Wheel train is one of the best, most incredible train journeys in the world. The views of Switzerland from atop the mountain are amazingly panoramic and breathtaking. Later on, drive to Interlaken, which is a world famous Swiss town located in the Bernese Oberland mountains between the lakes of Thun and Brienz. Finally, return to the hotel for a comfortable overnight stay.

Day 16: Switzerland - Mt. Titlis, Lucerne and Zurich Orientation Tour

After a scrumptious breakfast, begin your adventurous journey to Mt. Titlis. On a hair-raising and unforgettable 45 minutes long ride to the top, switching three different cable cars, the ride is nothing short of awe-inspiring. Along the way you will witness the scenery changing from green meadows and scenic lakes to snow clad mountains. The last leg of the ride is on the famous Rotair, the world's first revolving cable car that offers beautiful panoramic views of the surrounding glaciers, mountains and scenery. Once atop Mt. Titlis, what awaits visitors is breathtaking views of the Alps from either the sun terrace or from the famous "south face window" of the mountain. However, there's more. If the weather permits you can also enjoy a thrilling ride on the famous 'Ice Flyer' along with the snow park. After the great Mt. Titlis experience, we proceed to Lucerne, a beautiful city located at the northern tip of Lake Lucerne, where you will see the Lion Monument called Löwendenkmal built in memory of the loyal Swiss guards. Stroll along the banks of Lake Lucerne to experience attractions like the Kapellbrücke – The Chapel Bridge and the Spreuerbrücke, the two traditional wooden bridges of Lucerne. Spend some free time shopping at the famous 'Bucherer' for Swiss watches, jewellery and souvenirs.

Later, we proceed to Zurich. Begin your orientation tour, including sights such as Bahnhofstrasse, the Gross Munster, the Frau Munster, the Rathaus and St. Peter's Church. With a diameter of 8.7 metres (28 feet), the clock face of St. Peter's Church is the largest in all of Europe. Enjoy a comfortable overnight stay at the hotel.
